

Artist Description Thoreau MacDonald (1901 - 1989) Canadian Group of Painters MacDonald was the son of Group of Seven member J.E.H. MacDonald. He was self-taught, but had worked on commercial art with his father. His formative years were spent in rural areas near High Park, Toronto, and Thornhill, Ontario. Thoreau's drawings and writings about the wild plants and animals native to these parts reflect his deep concern for and support of nature conservation. He became a master in creating detailed line drawings of natural objects set within their stylized habitats. Thoreau MacDonald's drawings and paintings are held at the University of Toronto, Queen's University, McGill University, Art Gallery of Ontario, Kleinburg's McMichael Canadian Art Collection, Art Gallery of Hamilton, London Regional Art Gallery, National Gallery of Canada, Winnipeg Art Gallery, Vancouver Art Gallery, Upper Canada College in Toronto, Dartmouth College in Hanover, New Hampshire, and the Victoria and Albert Museum, London, England.
