**Artist Description** Ernest John Hutchins (1880 – 1935 ENG / CAD) Born in England around 1880, he came to Canada and worked as an artist in Winnipeg and the Canadian Rockies from 1907 to 1912. A naive landscape painter. Working in watercolour, ink and pencil, his subjects include demolished buildings such as forts, vanished urban views, the Prairie landscape and the Rocky Mountains of Alberta and British Columbia. His work is included in the collection of the Royal Ontario Museum. On 24 November 1904, he married Gertrude Mable Milnes at Middlesex County, England. They had five children: He died of tuberculosis at Lincolnshire, England on June 8th 1935.
