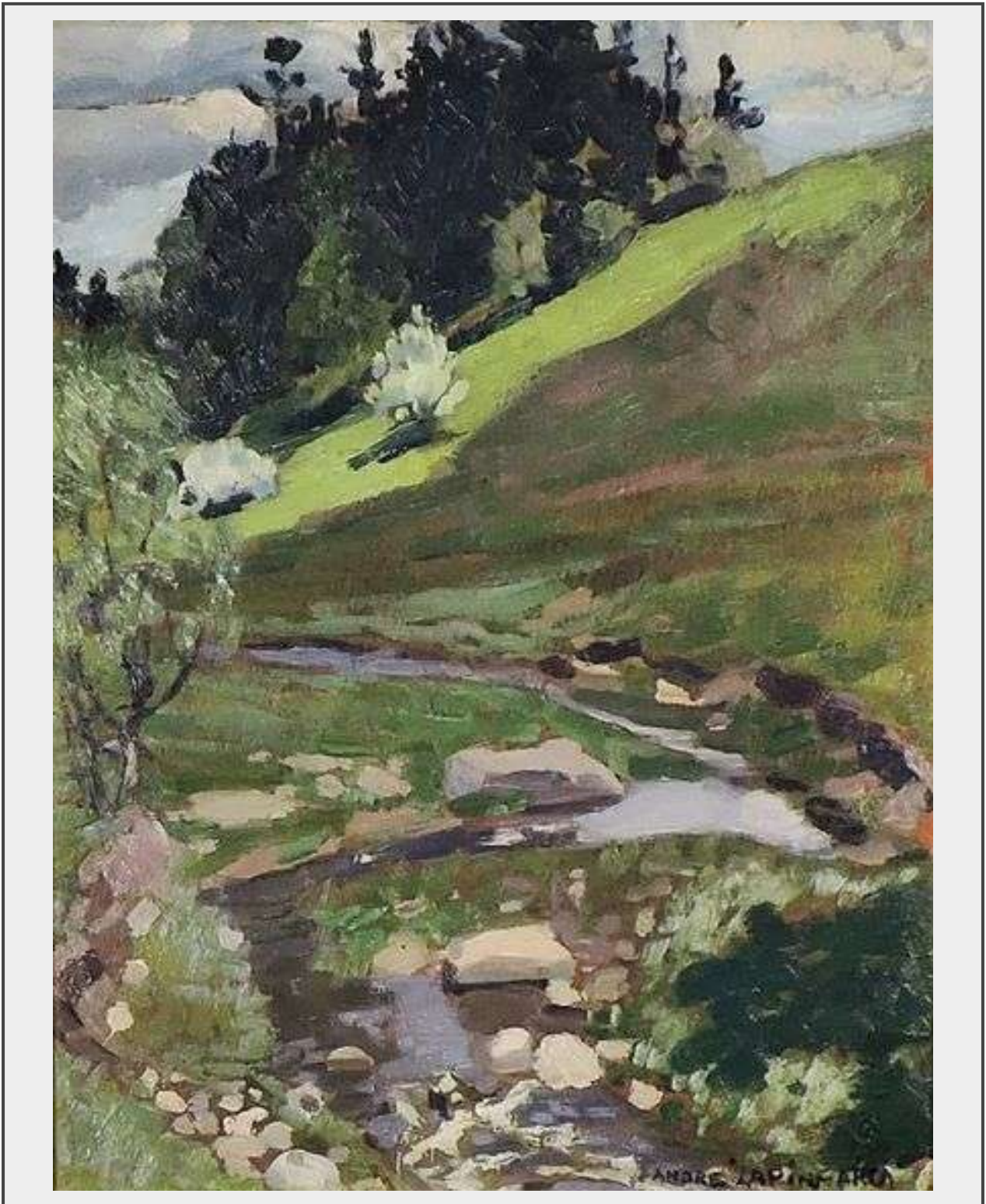

LOT 101 - André Lapine Spring Stream Landscape



Artist Description André Lapine (1866 – 1952 LAT / CAD) Imperial Academy of Arts (RUS), R.C.A., O.S.A., C.S.G.A., C.S.P.W., Immigrating to Canada in 1905, where he became especially renowned for his depictions of horses. In 1907, where at the age of 40 Lapine began working with Fred Brigden at the Toronto Engraving Co. Attention to detail and perfection established Lapine as the best illustrator of horses in North America. His work was selected and purchased by the National Gallery of Canada as well as the Art Gallery of Ontario. Lapine's work is in many private and public

collections including the Agnes Jamieson Gallery located in Minden, Ontario Canada. The Agnes Jamison Gallery opened in 1981 to show case 41 Lapine paintings that were bequeathed to the Minden township by Frank Welch, a resident of the area. The Agnes Jamieson Gallery now houses over 100 of Lapine's works in their permanent collection.
