

Artist Description Herbert Joshua Ariss (1916 – 2009 CAD) R.C.A., O.S.A. Born in Guelph, Herbert Ariss was a member of Ontario Society of Artists, the Royal Canadian Academy of Arts, the Canadian Society of Painters in Watercolour and the Canadian Group of Painters. While at the Ontario College of Art he studied under Group of Seven member Franklin Carmichael and J.W. Beatty who was strongly associated with Group of Seven members. He is best known for sculpting and painting nudes and landscapes but also did some abstract art later in his career. He taught at many institutions including the H.P. Beal Technical Institute in London, Ontario and served with the Canadian Army from 1942 to 1946. Work: Nat.
