Artist Description Irmgard Micaela Burchard (1908 – 1964 SUI) It was only in her Brazilian exile – at the age of 34 – that Irmgard Burchard became an artist. In her younger years she drew and worked with ceramics, but nothing is known about this. She did not receive any artistic training at an art school. But she was acquainted with many great artists of the 20th century such as Klee, Kandinsky, Baumeister and many others, whose works she knew and exhibited. Based on catalogue lists, her work, which was created over a period of around 20 years, probably included around 600 paintings in a total of two dozen solo exhibitions. Only a small portion of these pictures have resurfaced. Sixteen works are in public museums and collections around the world. 32 photo reproductions of her early work, created in Brazil before 1945, are kept in Picasso's archive in Paris.
