Artist Description Herbert Sydney Palmer (1881 – 1970 CAD) O.S.A., R.C.A., A Toronto born Canadian artist. He was best known as a landscape painter who captured Canadian scenes. From 1901 to 1905, he studied under Frederick S. Challener and J.W. Beatty at the Central Ontario School of Art. In 1929 he collaborated with the artist Frederick Haines on The Settlement of Canada, an eight-panel mural installed at the Canadian National Exhibition in the Dominion Government Building. He was a secretary of the Royal Canadian Academy of Arts and the Ontario Society of Artists, and taught at the Ontario College of Art. He was a recipient of the Canadian Centennial Medal, and one of the founders of the Arts and Letters Club of Toronto. Palmer was awarded the inaugural Baxter Foundation Fellowship.
