LOT 88 - John Shapland - Costal Landscape



Artist Description John Shapland (1865 – 1929 UK) A seascape artist from the South West of England, many of his coastal scenes depict his beloved West country landscape, including views of Exmouth and Salcombe. He was the Principal of Exeter School of Art from 1899 to 1913. He painted in oil, watercolour and gouache and exhibited at the Royal Academy, (5 works), the Paris Salon and in the U.S.A. He also exhibited 2 works at the Walker Art Gallery in Liverpool, and several at other Galleries in the UK. His principal works include 'Fairy Led' and 'Paradise Lost'. He is listed in the Dictionary of British Artists and Grant Waters' Dictionary of British Artists Working 1900-1950.
