LOT 9 - Rita Letendre - "Asor" '79 Contemporary Serigraph



Artist Description Rita Letendre (1928 – 2021 CAD) R.C.A., Order of Canada, National Order of Quebec, Order of Ontario A Canadian painter, muralist, and printmaker associated with Les Automatistes and the Plasticiens. She was an Officer of the Order of Canada and a recipient of the Governor General's Award. Early paintings used vibrant oils defined in loose patterns of repeated geometric shapes to suggest a sense of movement. Eventually shifting from the abstract Automatiste style to the more ordered, geometric mode of the Plasticiens. Colour fields are broken apart and expanded, while a reduced range of pigmentation creates a feeling of intensity. By the 1960s Letendre had reached an international audience exhibiting in New York and at the National Gallery of Canada.
