

Artist Description Thomas Harrison Wilkinson (1847 – 1929 CAD) O.S.A, R.C.A Born in Bradford, Yorkshire, England in 1847. He studied art in London. In 1870, Wilkinson immigrated to Canada where he lived in London, Ontario. In 1872, he married Carrie O'Cochrane of Kingston and made a home in Toronto. During his career, Wilkinson traveled and painted throughout Canada from Muskoka, Parry Sound, Georgian Bay, Montreal, Quebec, Lake Louise, the Rocky Mountains and British Colombia. He also traveled to North Carolina, England, Italy and Spain. Wilkinson was best known for his landscapes, seascapes, pastorals and streetscapes, working in watercolor and oil. His works were also featured in the exhibition "Historical Water Colours of Canada West: The collection of Mr. Percy C. Band" at the Dundas Historical Society Museum, Dundas, Ontario (1961).
