Artist Description André Lapine (1866 – 1952 LAT / CAD) Imperial Academy of Arts (RUS), R.C.A., O.S.A., C.S.G.A., C.S.P.W. Emigrating to Canada in 1905, Lapine became especially renowned for his equine illustrations. In 1907 Lapine began working with Fred Brigden at the Toronto Engraving Co. Attention to detail and perfection established André Lapine as the greatest illustrator of horses in North America. Lapine's work is in many private and public collections including the Agnes Jamieson Gallery located in Minden, Ontario Canada. His work was selected and purchased by the National Gallery of Canada as well as the Art Gallery of Ontario. The Agnes Jamison Gallery opened in 1981 to showcase 41 of Lapine's paintings that were bequeathed to the Minden township by Frank Welch, a resident of the area. The Agnes Jamieson Gallery now houses over 100 of Lapine's pieces in their permanent collection.
