Artist Description John Kasyn (1926 – 2008 POL / CAD) O.S.A., C.S.P.W.C. John Kasyn was raised in Winnipeg and moved to Toronto in 1940. He attended Central Technical School and the Ontario College of Art, and worked at Design Studios for eight years as an art director, before devoting himself full time to his painting. Kasyn's work is shown in galleries across Canada, and his paintings are in many important collections in both Canada and the United States, including the Montreal Museum of Fine Arts as well as the travelling collection of the Art Gallery of Ontario. Kasyn's oils and watercolours of old houses in the inner core of Toronto, depicting buildings that are fast disappearing from the scene, and his meticulous and nostalgic paintings of abandoned barns and gently rolling fields have won him many admirers across Canada, as well as in the United States.
